Dear Indy Burn / Indy Burn Plus coach,

I'm pleased to hear several coaches have already made other training field arrangements through March. As we mentioned at this week's Team Manager meeting, if you have games or a tournament in mid March, you may wish to seek alternative training sites. The cold, wet weather is forecast for at least another week, making a PSC field opening before March 10th very unlikely. The Fields Crew will open some 'open training areas' as soon as possible (MJGSC north open area and perhaps some of the (south) Rec areas of NWW). However, outdoor training on PSC fields will not begin until the fields dry and the grass begins to grow. Use of the full size fields at NWW and MJGSC north for training is still at least two weeks away, if not more. We've a very full game hosting schedule this spring and those fields will be used for some games. Michael Morrison will keep us informed. We're exploring renting turf fields at the high school or SportZone.

If your team plays CIYSL or GIRLS, free reschedules must be completed this week. If your league schedule listed any home games before 4/5/08, be advised those games should have been listed as "to be scheduled" and are so marked on PSC website. There are no PSC hosted Spring 2008 games before 4/5/08.

If the temperature is below 32 degrees or if the heat index is above 95 degrees, please cancel outdoor activities.

If you're interested in giving private lessons, please let me know. We are regularly asked by parents for referrals and would like to keep the business in house. Please do not give private lessons to a player on your team.
