

## **Pike Soccer Club & Indy Burn Double Roster Policy**

**PSC and IB discourage a child playing on two soccer teams during the same season yet does not prohibit it. Each child wishing to double roster must be approved by both coaches and the Director(s) Coaching involved.**

**The following four situations address a player playing for two TRAVEL teams.**

**1. Players doubled rostered on two Indy Burn teams:**

**a. Secondary Players necessary to keep team together and asked by a Coach(i.e. two u10 teams needing to share players). This rare situation is determined by Director Coaching and not by the Coaches or Managers. The cost of IYSA player fee is paid to second team.**

**b. Secondary Players approaching Coach pay IB Club fee and IYSA player registration fee.\* (i.e. parent wants child to play on two teams, i.e. true age and play up).**

**2. Players doubled rostered from outside Indy Burn - Pike Soccer Club:**

**a. Secondary Players necessary to keep team together and asked by a Coach pay IB Club fee and IYSA double roster player registration fee.\* (i.e. team may fall apart without player). This very rare situation is determined by Director Coaching and not by Coaches or Managers. (Not allowed by ISL.)**

**b. Secondary Players approaching Indy Burn Coach pay full Primary player IB fees.\* (i.e. parent wants child to play on two teams).**

**\*Plus Secondary Players pay share of participating tournaments for all four types of player situations.**

### **Double Roster Indy Burn and Pike Soccer Club Rec:**

**In the case of a child wishing to play on both a PSC Rec or Rec Plus team and an Indy Burn travel team in the same season: PSC policy is the child is a "primary" player on the Indy Burn travel team. Due to the nature of time and financial commitment to a travel team, PSC does not allow a "primary" PSC Rec or PSC Rec Plus player to be a "secondary" Indy Burn travel player. PSC does allow the player to be Primary Indy Burn and Secondary PSC Rec Plus. There is no "secondary" Rec Plus player fee discount. Full fees are paid for both teams.**

**In the rare instance of a parent of a PSC Rec player requesting, and an IB Coach wishing to roster, true "part time" travel team player status, in addition to both Directors Coaching approval, both Travel Coordinator and Recreation Coordinator must agree to this exception. Even if the Travel Coordinator reduces the team's fee assessment, the player remains "Primary" on the travel team and "Secondary" on the Rec Plus team. IYSA prohibits a "Secondary" travel player without the companion "Primary" travel or Rec plus team; thus there can be no "primary" Rec and "secondary" travel IYSA registration. July 8, 2002**
