YOUR PRIVACY AND NO SOLICITATION

You can help. If you see someone putting a flyer on windshields in the parking lots of the two Parks, please let them know it is not permitted, to stop, to collect the ones they've already placed, and that they will be invoiced clean up costs. PSC does not approve any leafleting of member vehicles by others.

Part of PSC's legal agreement with Indy Parks is to enforce, to our best ability, Indy Parks' NO SOLICITATION policy. PSC is to assure that no person, or entity, shall distribute any **circulares**, cards or written matter, or **post**, paste or affix **any** placard, notice or **sign** in or on any Indy Parks property, or demonstrate or sell any article for private pecuniary gain, or **advertise at Park Property** without prior written consent from the Department. The only current exceptions are ones PSC preapproves, for example, paid PSC sponsors Land o Frost, St. Vincents Sports Medicine, etc.

If you are approached on Park property to buy something or attend some function, etc., please tell the person it is not permitted and to stop.

CODES OF CONDUCT

Although the Club usually gives warnings, be advised particularly serious violations may result in your expulsion. The Codes include a pledge to NOT consume alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs on Park property. There are 1500 children in the Club who deserve to breath smoke free air during their time in the Park. PSC continues to hire off duty police to help keep PSC members safe.

INDY PARK RULES

PSC Members use Indy Parks facilities according to PSC's Special Use Permit. In addition, all Parks users must adhere to Indy Parks Rules and Regulations which include:

1. Park hours are dawn to dusk.
2. Firearms are not permitted in parks.
3. Possession of alcohol is not permitted in parks without a permit from the Park Board for a special use.
4. Vehicles are not permitted on the grass.
5. No open fires other than in grills.
6. Dogs must be on a leash that is less than twenty feet in length unless

in the Canine Companion Zones. **PSC prohibits, for health and safety reasons, pets on the soccer fields.**

7. Bicycles are not allowed on gravel paths.

8. Private vendor sales in parks require a permit.
