Want to be 'right' 100% of the time? Become a Referee

Pike Soccer Club hosts the best Referee Development Academy in Indiana. Refs are ALL AGES, including adults. Depending upon the course and the candidate's maturity, the lower age limits are around: 10 years old for Junior Refs; 12 years old for Grade 9 Refs; and 13 years old for Grade 8 Refs. At PSC, "Junior Refs" ref U5 and U6 Rec games. The next level "Grade 9 Refs" ref U7-U12 Rec games. The next level "Grade 8 Refs" ref travel team games. The "Grade" is the level Ref course and does NOT refer to school system grades.

Twice per year, Pike Soccer Club hosts Referee license courses. Check the website for details.

Jr. Refs are trained week prior to each Rec season.

PSC 3v3 Live is a one-day tournament open to teams ages U6 to Adult and both recreational and competitive skill levels. Teams may register up to 6 players. \$170 per team includes at least 4 games, all fees (referees) and a t-shirt for each player. The top 3 teams in each division receive a custom medal and an invitation to the 3v3 Live Regional Final. A top performance at Regional's qualifies your team to compete at the 2011 3v3 Live Winter National Finals 2012.

Why 3v3 Soccer? 3v3 soccer is a great way for kids and adults to get out and have a good time. 3v3 soccer promotes individual and team skills. 3v3 soccer is played on a short fields, this is usually half or less than a regular field.
